Paragon[®] MCa30 is a synthetic dolomite brick produced from high quality natural magnesia sinter, calcia-enriched to give the product physical attributes that accommodate excellent coating stability, flexibility and the ability to withstand thermal spalling. The added magnesia enables MCa30 to better withstand spalling due to loss of coating, giving the product added operating life.
